

Local Connection Notes
(Former Fremington Army Camp site), including

Papaver Close, Parade Avenue, Cadet Lane, Company Road, Omaha Way, Seaking Road

Applicants should have a local connection to Fremington Parish to be considered for this property, by demonstrating one of the following:

- At least one adult in the household was resident continuously in the Parish for a minimum of five years immediately prior to offer or occupation
- At least one adult in the household has been in continuous employment* for at least 16 hours a week in the Parish for at least five years immediately prior to offer or occupation. *Employment is defined as employment other than of a casual nature, therefore permanent work, of a minimum of a 16 hour contract per week for a continuous period of at least five years and without a break in the employment period of more than three months
- Strong link by reason of birth or family. Have a connection through a close family member (normally mother, father, brother, sister, son or daughter) where the family member is currently resident there in and has been so for a continuous period of five years immediately prior to the offer or occupation)

In the event that after 4 weeks of advertising no applicant has the local connection to Fremington Parish an applicant will be considered with local connection to one of the following adjoining Parishes: Instow, Westleigh, Tawstock and Horwood, Lovacott and Newton Tracey.

In the event that after a further 4 weeks (8 weeks in total) of advertising, no applicant has the local connection to Fremington Parish or the aforementioned Adjoining Parishes an applicant will be sought with local connection to North Devon district.
