**Introduction:**

This report provides the latest key information from Devon Home Choice and covers 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024 to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024.

**Households registered with Devon Home Choice:**

The total number of households in housing need (Bands A to D) increased slightly from 18,634 on 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024 to 18,677 on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025.

In the second quarter of this year across Devon, East Devon, Exeter, South Hams, Torridge and West Devon had a reduction on the number of households in Bands A to D with Torridge having the highest decrease of 26.6% followed by South Hams and West Devon with drops of 11% and 10.5% respectively. All other local authorities in Devon saw an increase in numbers of households in housing needs (Bands A to D) with Teignbridge having the highest increase of 13.6% and Torbay having the lowest increase of 2.5% of households.

The number of households in Band E overall has decreased by 1.7% since 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024, from 27,379 to 26,924 and is currently 31% of the total DHC register.

As always, one bedroom properties remain the greatest need across all local authority areas (Table 2 & 2a), with 54% of applicants (Bands A to D) requiring a one bedroom home.

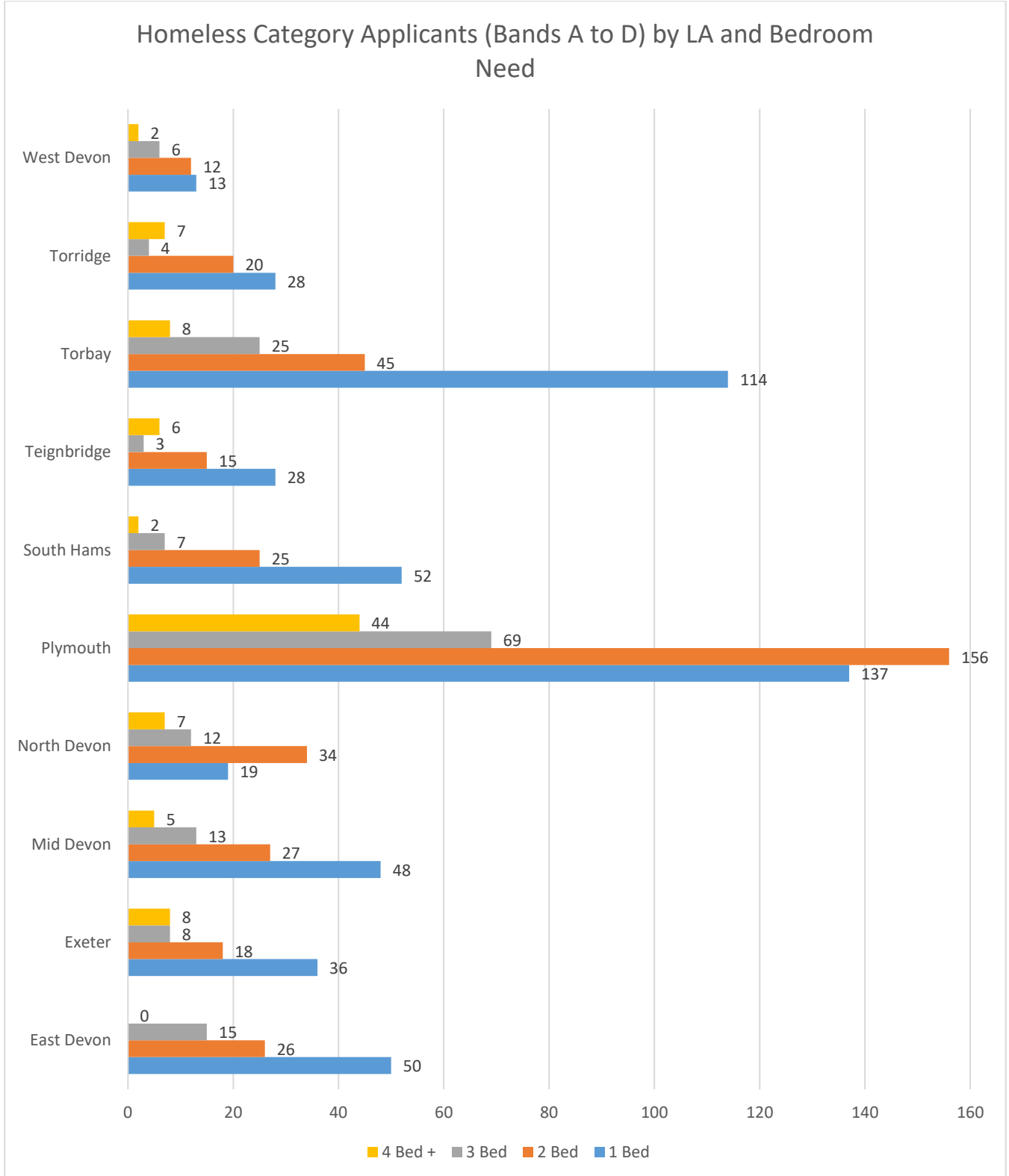

Chart 1 below shows the breakdown of Homeless Category applicants by bedroom need across Local Authority areas. 1 bed need is also highest for this category across all areas except for North Devon and Plymouth where the 1 bed need has been surpassed by 2 bed need. The number of 1 bed applicants in East Devon, Torridge and West Devon have dropped since Q2, most likely due to extensive renewals exercise being undertaken.

Table 3 below shows the numbers on the register in housing need (Band A – D) in each local authority area by quarter whilst Table 3a shows the same for Bands A to E.

Decreases in applications for individual LAs per quarter are likely to be the result of increased renewal activity. Across Devon for both tables when compared to the previous quarter, Plymouth had the highest increase in numbers.

Table 5 and Charts 2 & 3 below show the number of bids placed, and the number of households who have placed at least one bid, during Q3 of 2024/25 and the corresponding quarter in the previous 3 years, as well as Q2 for 2024/25.

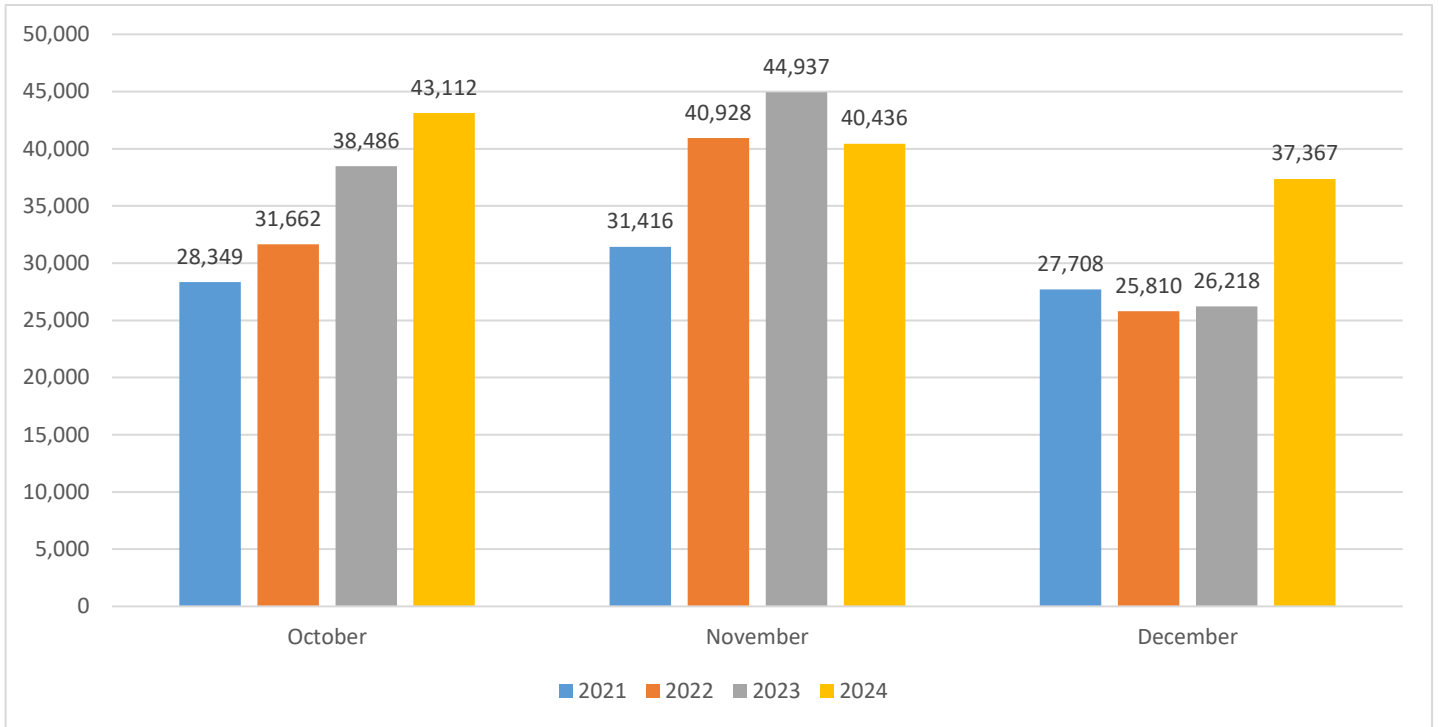
Quarter 3 figures for 2024/25 had the highest number of bids for October and December when compared to the previous Quarter 3 figures, however there were more bids in November 2023.

The total number of bids decreased by 1% from the last quarter.

**Chart 3 - Numbers of bidders by month:**

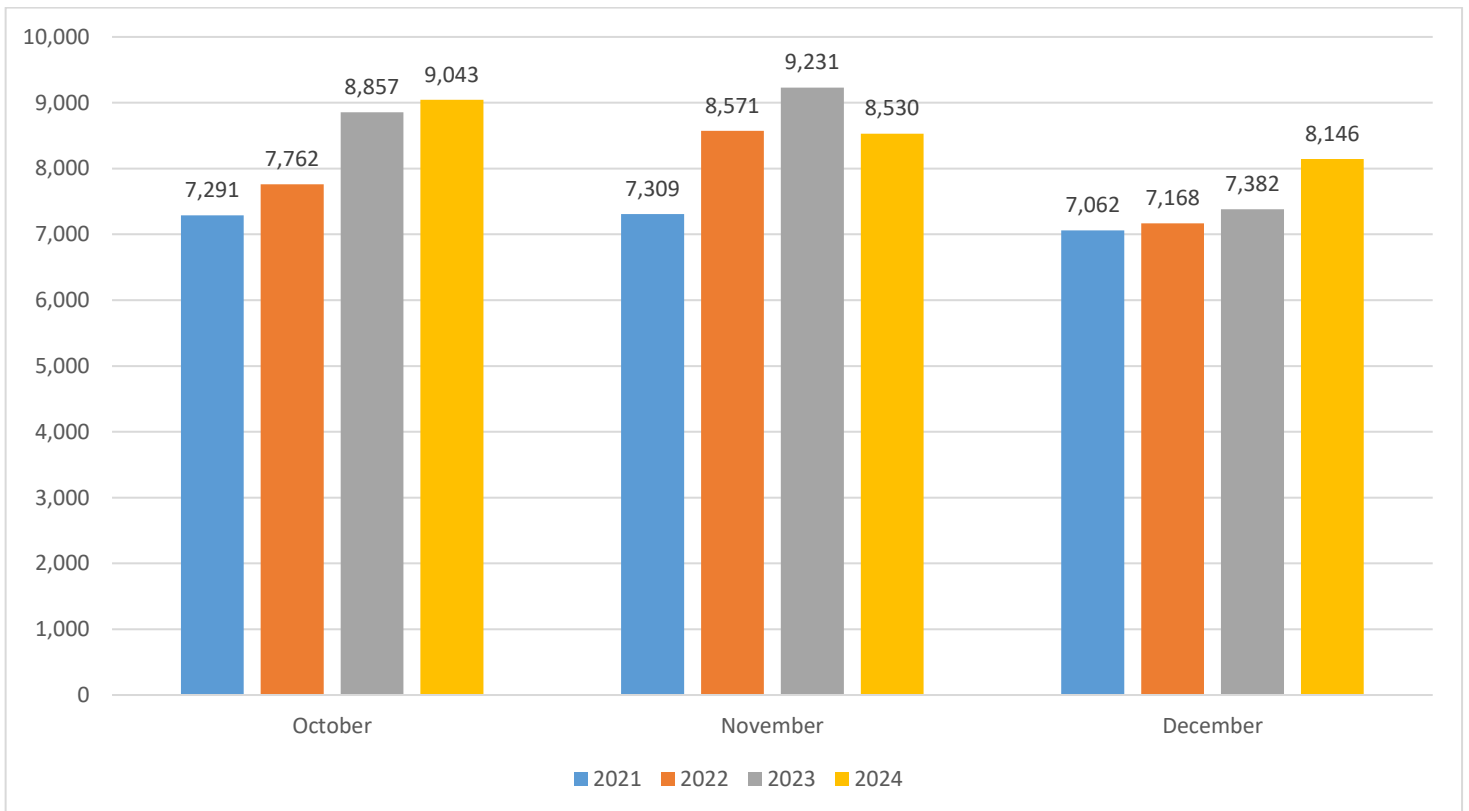


Table 6 shows how bids have been placed throughout the previous quarters (October 2023 to December 2024).

There has been a 1% increase in the figures for applicants on autobids and backoffice/management bids whilst bids placed on the website have dropped by 2%. However, bids placed via the website remain the main method of placing bids for applicants.

The percentage of inactive applicants in Band B has increased since the previous quarter across Devon by 2%. Across all Bands, the number of inactive users has also increased since the last Quarter by 2%.

48% of applicants in Band E are considered to be inactive, also increased from the previous Quarter by 1%.

## Homes let:

There were 653 general needs homes let in the 3 months from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2024 (Table 13 below) compared to 679 lets in Q3 of 2023/24. There were 813 lets in Q3 of 2022/2023 and 736 lets in Q3 of 2021/22.

73% of all general homes let were let to applicants in Band B.
