Introduction:

This report provides the latest key information from Devon Home Choice and covers 1st July 2024 to 30th September 2024.

Households registered with Devon Home Choice:

The total number of households in housing need (Bands A to D) increased slightly from 18,260 on 1st July 2024 to 18,634 on 1st October 2024, a rise of 2.05%.

In the second quarter of this year across Devon, East Devon, Exeter and North Devon had a reduction on the number of households in Bands A to D with North Devon having the highest decrease of 8.23% followed by Exeter with drop of 2.03%. All other local authorities in Devon saw an increase in numbers of households in housing needs (Bands A to D) with West Devon having the highest increase of 9.71% and Teignbridge having the lowest increase of 0.19% of households.

The number of households in Band E overall has increased by 0.97% since 1st July 2024, from 8,661 to 8,745 and is currently 32% of total DHC register.

Note: In table 1 above the percentages given for Bands A – D refer to the proportion of households in housing need who are in that Band (e.g. 22% of all households in housing need across Devon are in Band B). The



percentage given for Band E refers to the proportion of households in Band E of all those registered (e.g. 32% of households registered across Devon are in Band E).

One bedroom properties remain the greatest need across all local authority areas (Table 2 & 2a), with 54% of applicants requiring a one bedroom home.

Chart 1 below shows the breakdown of Homeless Category applicants by bedroom need across Local Authority areas. 1 bed need is also highest for this category across all areas except for North Devon which has the same highest number for 1 bed as well as for 2 bed homeless applicants. The number of 1 bed applicants in East Devon has dropped since Q2, most likely due to extensive renewals exercise being undertaken.






Table 3 below shows the numbers on the register in housing need (Band A - D) in each local authority area by quarter whilst Table 3a shows the same for Bands A to E.

Decreases in applications for individual LAs per quarter are likely to be the result of increased renewal activity. Across Devon for both tables when compared to the previous quarter, North Devon had the highest increase in numbers.

Table 4 below shows the number of New Applications received by each local authority in each of the last six quarters. Plymouth saw the highest increase in numbers of new applications received during Q2 2024/25 compared to the previous quarter. The total number of New Applications across Devon for Q2 2024/25 was the highest since figures were monitored back in Q1 2021/22.

Bidding patterns:

Table 5 and Charts 2 & 3 below show the number of bids placed, and the number of households who have placed at least one bid, during Q2 of 2024/25 and the corresponding quarter in the previous 3 years, as well as Q1 for 2024/25.

Quarter 2 figures for 2024/25 had the highest number of bids for July and August when compared to the previous Quarter 2 figures, however September had more bids in 2023/24.

The total number of bids increased by 3.13% from the last quarter.

Chart 2 - Numbers of bids by month:




Chart 3 - Numbers of bidders by month:






Table 6 shows how bids have been placed throughout the previous quarters (July 2023 to September 2024).

There has been a 2% decrease in the figures for applicants using the mobile app to place bids whilst website figures have increased by 2% compared to the last quarter. Bids placed via the website remain the main method of placing bids for applicants.

The percentage of inactive applicants in Band B has increased since the previous quarter across Devon by 4%. Across all Bands, the number of inactive users has also increased since the last Quarter.

47% of applicants in Band E are considered to be inactive, an increase from the previous Quarter of 17%.

Homes let:

There were 622 general needs homes let in the 3 months from 1st July to 30th September 2024 (Table 13 below) compared to 812 lets in Q2 of 2023/24. There were 753 lets in Q2 of 2021/222 and 668 lets in Q3 of 2022/23.

71% of all general homes let were let to applicants in Band B.
