If you input an address and there is no search result it may be because the address is either not in North Devon or the address you have input may be slightly flawed e.g. if you put in Oakley and it should be Oakleigh.

Click on 3 lines in top left corner







Drop down the 'Boundaries' option



Click/Tick in the box to the left of 'Parishes'



Use the 'search' tool on the far right of screen



Input **any address** that you wish to check to see if it is within the Parish boundary, once the address is shown, click on the address below the address search list. This will provide a red pin on the map



Use the minus button in the far right of screen to zoom out and get perspective of the map until you can see the Parish boundaries displayed. You can then see if the search address is within the relevant Parish boundary.



For absolute confirmation of the Parish – click on the red pin then minimise the 'Quick search' box. Re open the Quick search panel. Repeat – click on the red pin and wait for 'Feature information' see final image below. If the Feature Information does not quickly display, then minimise the Quick Search box, re open the Quick Search and if necessary click on the red pin again.
