Occupation Criteria (also known as Local Connection) Notes

The occupational criteria shall be deemed to be satisfied either by a person who can evidence that:-

- (a) at least one adult in the household was resident continuously in North Devon
 District (or Devon County Council as the case may be) for a minimum of five
 years immediately prior to occupation; or
- (b) at least one adult of the household was resident in North District District (or Devon County Council as the case maybe) for five years within the previous ten years immediately prior to occupation; or
- (c) at least one parent, guardian, child or sibling of at least one adult in the household, has been resident in North Devon District (or the Devon County Council as the case may be) for a minimum of 5 years immediately prior to occupation; or
- (d) at least one adult in the household has been in continuous employment for at least 16 hours a week in North Devon District (or Devon County Council as the case may be) for at least five years immediately prior to occupation; or
- (e) at least one adult in the household is a Qualifying Person as set out in the Allocation of Housing (Qualification Criteria for Armed Forces) (England) Regulations 2012
